



El supports children from birth to age 3, who are challenged with or at risk of developmental delays.

We partner with and support families caring for young children receiving El services, providing a family-centered approach. We provide an expanded toolkit of techniques to foster development, learning, advocacy, and communication.

Our specialized services help to enhance the development and learning of each child through individualized and developmentally appropriate activities within their everyday life experience.

Relationship Building

El assists the development of children in 3 main areas:

Learning

Developing Independence



The child and family must be a resident of one of the following towns: Abington, Avon, Bridgewater, Brockton, East Bridgewater, Easton, Holbrook, Rockland, Stoughton, West Bridgewater, or Whitman.

Eligibility

The child has not 'reached' age appropriate milestones in one or more areas of development. The child is diagnosed with a specific condition that may result in a developmental delay. The child has a medical or social history that might place the child at risk for developmental delay. The child must be found eligible in one of these three areas: Developmental Delay, Diagnosis, or Risk Factors.

Who Pays?

The Massachusetts Department of Public Health, MassHealth, and private health insurance fund EI services. Families are not charged for EI services. There are no copayments, deductibles, or other costs to the family.

How are Referrals Made?

Anyone (a parent, doctor, caregiver, teacher, or friend) can make a referral to EI. A prescription or insurance referral from a healthcare provider is not needed.

Who Provides Services?

EI works in partnership with family members to ensure that therapeutic activities and strategies occur throughout the child's day to enhance their development.

Services may be provided by:

- Developmental Specialist
- Physical Therapist
- Occupational Therapist
- Speech – Language Pathologist
- Licensed Mental Health Counselors
- Social Worker
- Nurse
- Nutritionist
- Other specialty service providers
