Through a dedicated staff of more than 1,300, BAMSI supports over 25,000 individuals a year, operating more than 110 programs throughout the Commonwealth.



WHO WE ARE

The Counseling and Community Resources Division of BAMSI includes an outpatient mental health clinic and outreach sites that serve people with wide-ranging mental health needs. In philosophy and practice, we are concerned about the dignity of each individual and respect individual differences. We seek to empower those served to attain their full potential, and use a variety of therapeutic approaches to achieve desirable outcomes. By coordinating our services with local public and private agencies, we maximize resources for those served, promoting success in all aspects of life – family, work, and community.

WHO WE SERVE

We serve people of all ages who are experiencing personal difficulties in their lives due to troubling psychiatric and/or emotional symptoms. These could arise from factors that include stress (current or past), life crises, problems in school, developmental issues, mental illness, adjustment disorders, and substance abuse. Offering great service flexibility, we can see clients at home, school, work, and other community locations.

PROGRAM DESIGN

The BAMSI counseling staff is made up of a multi-disciplinary team that includes psychiatrists who see adults and children; licensed psychologists; licensed clinical social workers; certified psychiatric nurse clinical specialists; and licensed master's level mental health counselors. The Whitman Counseling Center is a community-based mental health center licensed by the Department of Public Health and accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities.

All of BAMSI's clinic-based services occur in its counseling center in Whitman, with additional outreach locations designed to meet the needs of those for whom Whitman Counseling Center is not as appropriate. BAMSI's goal in the field of mental health is to be available and convenient for persons in need of services. Six outreach locations support individual, group, couples, and family counseling. Seven different therapists will work at these outreach sites, providing convenient, community-based therapies.

The services this staff provides include:

- Individual therapy
- Couples therapy
- Child and family psychotherapy services
- Psychopharmacology evaluations and treatment
- Psychological testing
